The Arizona Supreme Court has adopted provisions for certification of process servers in its Code of Judicial Administration, Part 7, Chapter 2. Section 7-204(D)(4), defines the role and responsibilities of the presiding judge of superior court. It further authorizes the presiding judge to vest in another person the authority to exercise or discharge any power, duty or function vested in the presiding judge. One of the functions is to review application materials of applicants for certification as process servers in Mohave County. The Clerk of Superior Court for Mohave County, Virlynn Tinnell, has agreed to review applications and grant certification to those meeting standards established by the Supreme Court. Any application not granted by her under this authority will be forwarded to the presiding judge for review.

IT IS ORDERED vesting in Virlynn Tinnell, Clerk of Superior Court, authority to review applications for certification as process server and to grant those meeting applicable standards.
